APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM

Apple Hill Playhouse in Delmont, PA is accepting applications for its Summer Theatre Apprenticeship Program. From June through August, Apple Hill Playhouse will give young people a chance to learn theatre techniques in a hands-on professional setting.

Apple Hill Playhouse's Summer Season includes adult productions, Johnny Appleseed Children's Theatre Productions, and a children's mainstage production. This schedule places different demands on our theatre staff and apprentices should be prepared to train in any or all of the following areas:

- Set Building** - Learn how a set goes from conception to stage—including set painting
- Properties** - Learn about the selection and acquisition of stage properties and their organization before, during, and after a show.
- Costume Construction** - Learn how costumes are chosen, constructed, and altered. Learn how costumes are maintained, cleaned, and stored during a show.
- Stage Crew** - Learn how the actors on stage depend on the crew backstage by assisting with running lights, changing sets and props, and following cue sheets.
- Stage Managing** – Learn to professionally manage a show as assistant to the director. Learn how to professionally call a show once it arrives for rehearsals at the theater.
- **Facilities Management** – Learn how “little things matter” by assisting with upkeep of theatre buildings and grounds, assisting with house management.

All apprenticeship assignments will be made by the Apprenticeship Coordinator who will supervise and organize all activities. A minimum of 25 hours per week is expected.

The Apprenticeship Program will run mid-June through late-August. Apprentices serving the entire term will receive stipends of \$500.00 .
